

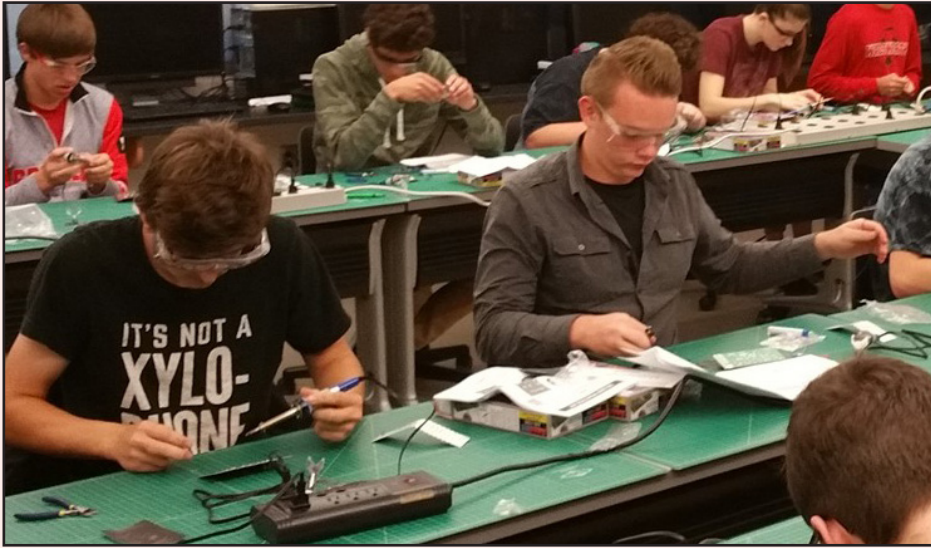

School District Demographics



Wadsworth City School District encompasses 25 square miles within Medina County, Ohio. We offer a diverse curriculum and highly qualified teaching staff who are focused on the future so that all of our students have the tools to succeed.

Our Schools

- 5 elementary schools (grades PK-4): Franklin, Isham, Lincoln, Overlook, Valley View
- 1 intermediate school (grades 5-6): Central Intermediate School
- 1 middle school (grades 7-8): Wadsworth Middle School
- 1 high school (grades 9-12): Wadsworth High School

We currently have a student population of 4,807 in grades PK-12.

Our Students (Class of 2019)

- 56% received college/post-secondary scholarships
- Class received merit-based scholarships for college/post-secondary education in the amount of \$2,200,000
- 4 National Merit Commended students
- SAT Average Score: Overall-1206; Math-614; Reading-593; Writing-593
- ACT Average Score: Overall-22.4; English-21.9; Math-22.9; Reading-22.3; Science-22.1
